CONTINUED
NOTES:

Alternate Net Control will follow the preamble by calling “CALIFORNIA” first then continuing on. ANCS will also call “CAL OES INLAND REGION” and/or “CAL OES MUTUAL AID REGION 4” (If CALIFORNIA doesn’t answer). Because “K4OES” is co-located with “W6EMA”, HQ NCS will not call INLAND or MAR 4 but may call for the Alternate. It is ‘assumed’ that HQ will always be staffed for the Net regardless of duties as NCS or not. **The NCS, when operating from HQ, will announce and document Inland and MAR IV as checking in their regular order on the Roll Call.**

An example for the NCS: “THIS IS CALIFORNIA, W6EMA, CONTINUING CALLING xxxxxxxx” -or- “THIS IS CALIFORNIA, W6EMA, CONTINUING CALLING FOR LATE OR MISSED xxxxxxxx”

An Example for the ANCS: “THIS IS THE ANCS, W6???, SANTA LUISA CONTINUING CALLING xxxxxxxx” -or- “THIS IS SANTA LUISA (just the station location used as the tactical call), CONTINUING CALLING FOR LATE OR MISSED xxxxxxxx”

NCS, ANCS & RELAY Stations are reminded to use the prowords “OVER” at a continuance of each transmission and “OUT” when terminating a contact, and if nothing is heard by the NCS or a Relay during an attempted contact then they will say “NOTHING HEARD”. As well as all of the other standard operating procedures during all transmissions.

NOTE: In this case the term EOC is actually just an acronym used to indicate the Communications Centers that is co-located in the same facility or on the same campus as the EOC. This takes up less space (shorter tactical call signs) on the roll call and is easier and quicker to pronounce while actually performing the roll call.

Occasionally, an Agency “EOC” or “Alternate EOC” and/or “Satellite” (an agency related station/location that is not co-located in the same facility or on the same campus as the EOC) may be checking in. If more than one is listed for an agency then the NCS/ANCS must account for this possibility when calling each agency with all listed in the Roll Call. One or the other has been occasionally missed.

The station and/or operators call sign listing format may be a bit confusing. If a Club Call is used then that call is in **bold** followed by a semi-colon (Example: **W6EMA**;) That call is then followed by the personal call(s) and first name(s) of the assigned station operator(s) separated by commas. In all like cases any other operators are included in that same line.

(Example: Santa Luisa EOC: **W6EMA**; W6xxx Fred, WA6xxx John, N6xx Bill)

There are up to six basic ways an entry may be displayed on the Roll Call.

- 1 - The EOC station only: Santa Luisa EOC: W6xxx Fred, WA6xxx John, N6xx Bill
- 2 - An Alternate EOC station only: Santa Luisa Alternate EOC: W6xxx Fred, WA6xxx John, (may be identified with the city name)
- 3 - A Satellite location/station only: (i.e. an agency related location/station not co-located with an EOC): Santa Luisa Satellite: W6xxx Fred, WA6xxx John

NOTE: The fourth and fifth are actually a combination of the either of first two above with the third.

- 4 – The EOC and/or a Satellite station: Santa Luisa EOC-or-Satellite: **W6EMA**; W6xxx Fred, WA6xxx John, N6xx Bill
- 5 – An Alternate EOC and/or a Satellite station: Santa Luisa Alternate EOC-or-Satellite: **W6EMA**; W6xxx Fred, WA6xxx John
- 6 – A Mobile station: A Mobile Comm. Center, Command Post or any mobile unit that is an agency related station: Santa Luisa Mobile: W6xxx Fred, WA6xxx John

However in all cases the responding station must always identify their actual operating location as 'EOC', 'Alternate EOC' or 'Satellite' or 'Mobile' as appropriate. The NCS must confirm all stations checking in by the circling the correct tactical call sign and the individual's Amateur call sign /name).
